We Promise:

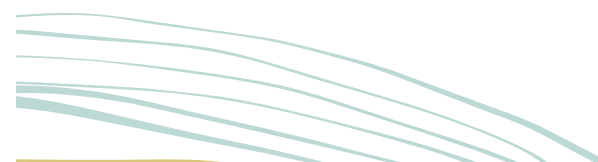
- to approach each step along the path to adoption with open hearts and minds and always put the child first
