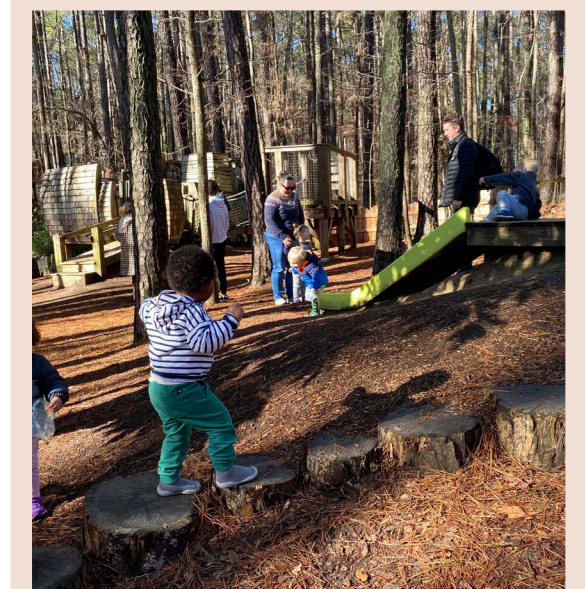

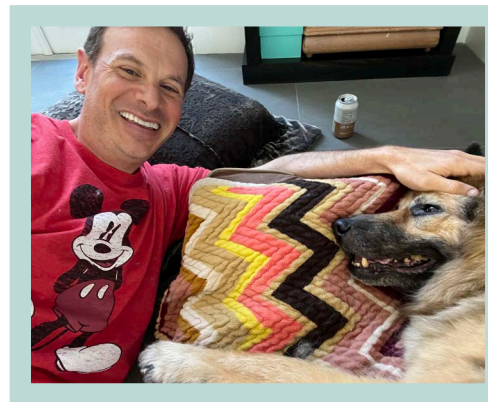
We love outdoor adventures!

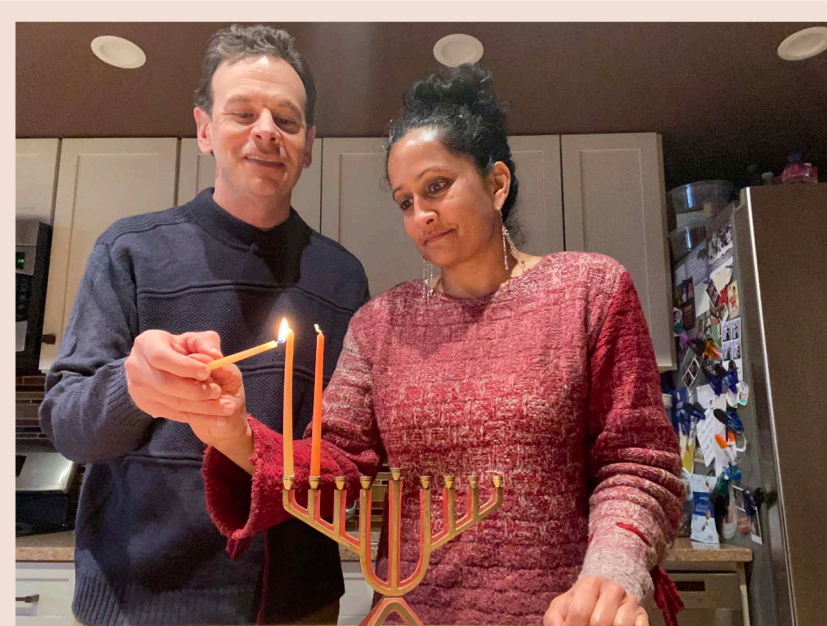
