


We met and fell in love in Denver, Colorado, ironically, at a Kentucky Derby Party.






Kelsey co-founded a community advocacy organization during COVID to keep people in their homes and fight against untrustworthy landlords. She helped stop more than 100 evictions.






Taylor is an amazing chef. We prioritize cooking healthy and delicious meals that we enjoy together as a family every night.


